Jiangshan Retreat

After two decades of living and working in Hangzhou, the owner of this unique home felt a growing desire to reconnect with his birthplace Jiangshan, a lush and tranquil region in Zhejiang Province. What began as a search for a weekend escape evolved into a vision for a lifelong sanctuary: a luxury home where contemporary comfort, local heritage, and nature could coexist in harmony.

One third of the original structure – formerly used as livestock quarters – was removed and replaced with a contemporary Honka CLT log home, designed in Shanghai by Nota Architects, prefabricated in Finland, and rebuilt on site in Jiangshan.
